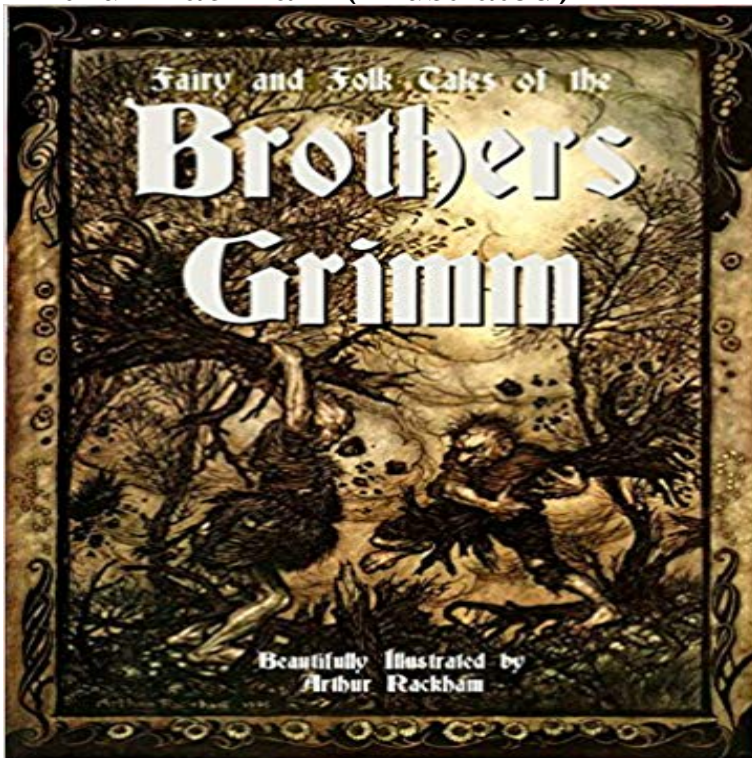


# Fairy and Folk Tales of the Brothers Grimm: Beautifully Illustrated by Arthur Rackham (Illustrated)



About Fairy and Folk Tales of the Brothers Grimm Welcome to the dark and brooding world of the Grimm brothers, it is their collection of fairytales that has shaped childrens literature and it is here that we find such figures as Little Red Riding Hood, Hansel and Gretel, The Frog Prince, Rapunzel, Rumpelstiltskin, Snow White and many others. Be warned, this collection of 63 stories are not the tales as presented by The Little Golden Book series or on the big screen by Walt Disney. These stories are how the Grimm brothers intended them to be heard. There is magic, wonder, and a world in which good triumphs... but there is also savage retribution, revenge, brutality, and torture! This magical edition is illustrated by the brilliant Arthur Rackham whose illustrations are highly sought after and give the tales a dark whimsical tone.

About the Brothers Grimm The brothers Grimm, Jacob (1785-1863) and Wilhelm (1786-1859), were born in Hanau, near Frankfurt, in the German state of Hesse. Throughout their lives they remained close friends, and both studied law at Marburg University. Jacob was a pioneer in the study of German philology, and although Wilhelms work was hampered by poor health the brothers collaborated in the creation of a German dictionary, not completed until a century after their deaths. But they were best (and universally) known for the collection of over two hundred folk tales they made from oral sources and published in two volumes of Nursery and Household Tales in 1812 and 1814.

Although their intention was to preserve such material as part of German cultural and literary history, and their collection was first published with scholarly notes and no illustration, the tales soon came into the possession of young readers. This was in part due to Edgar Taylor, who made the first English translation in 1823, selecting about fifty stories with the amusement of

some young friends principally in view. They have been an essential ingredient of childrens reading ever since. About the Illustrator of Fairy and Folk Tales of the Brothers Grimm - Arthur Rackham Arthur Rackham is widely regarded as one of the leading illustrators from the Golden Age of British book illustration which roughly encompassed the years from 1890 until the end of the First World War. During that period, there was a strong market for high quality illustrated books. Many of Rackhams books were produced in a de luxe limited edition. Arthur Rackhams works have become very popular since his death, both in North America and Britain.
