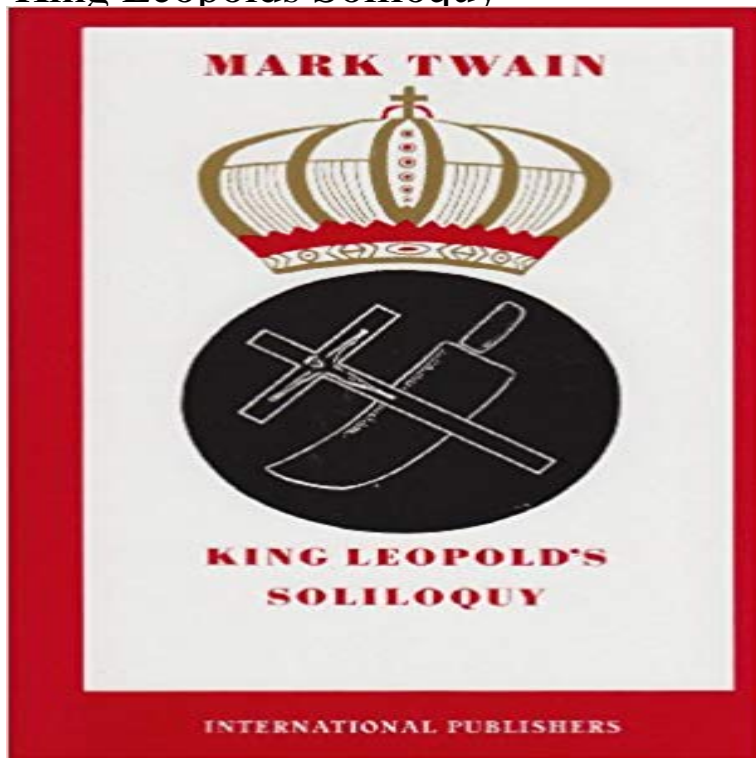


# King Leopolds Soliloquy
