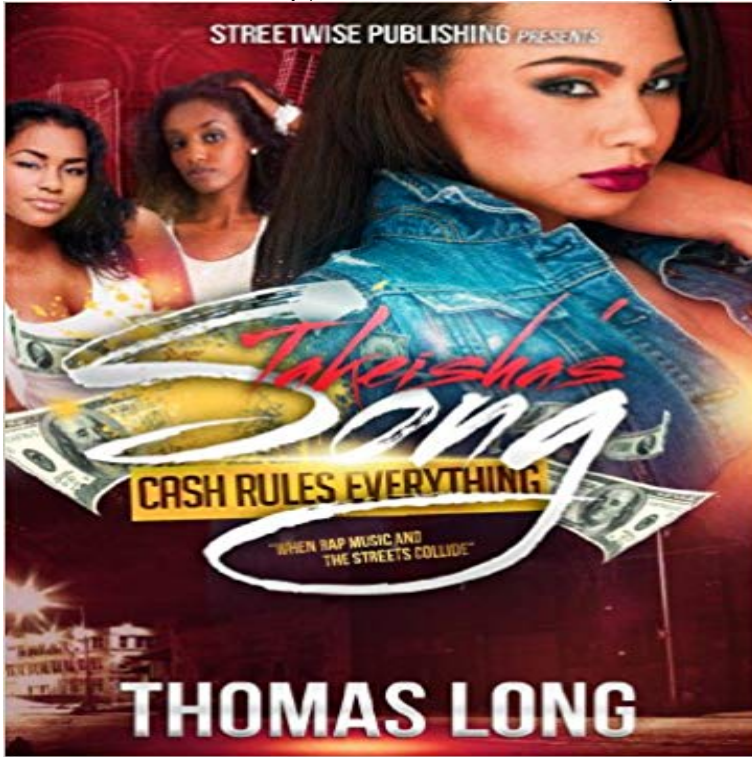


Takeishas Song: Cash Rules Everything
