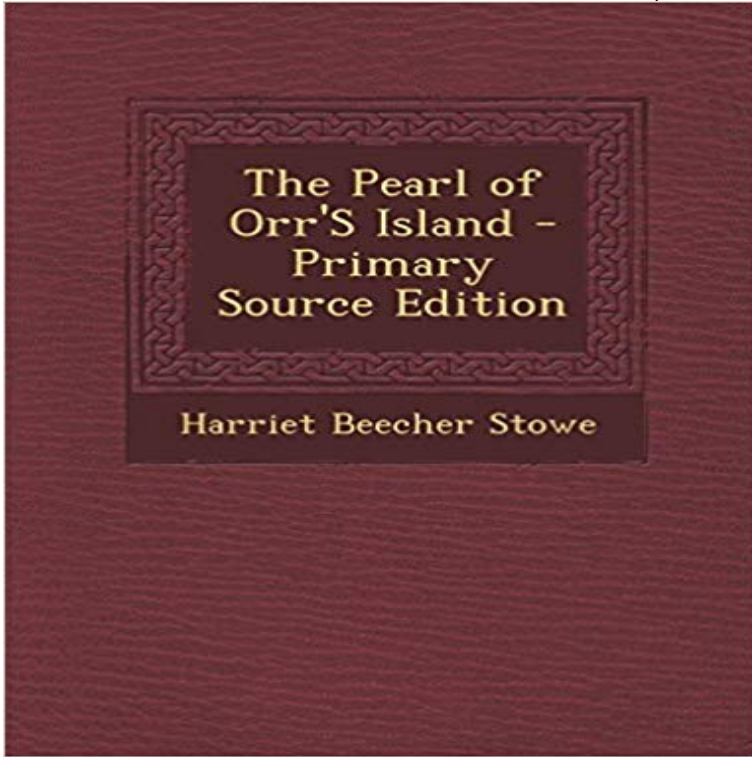


The Pearl of Orrs Island - Primary Source Edition
