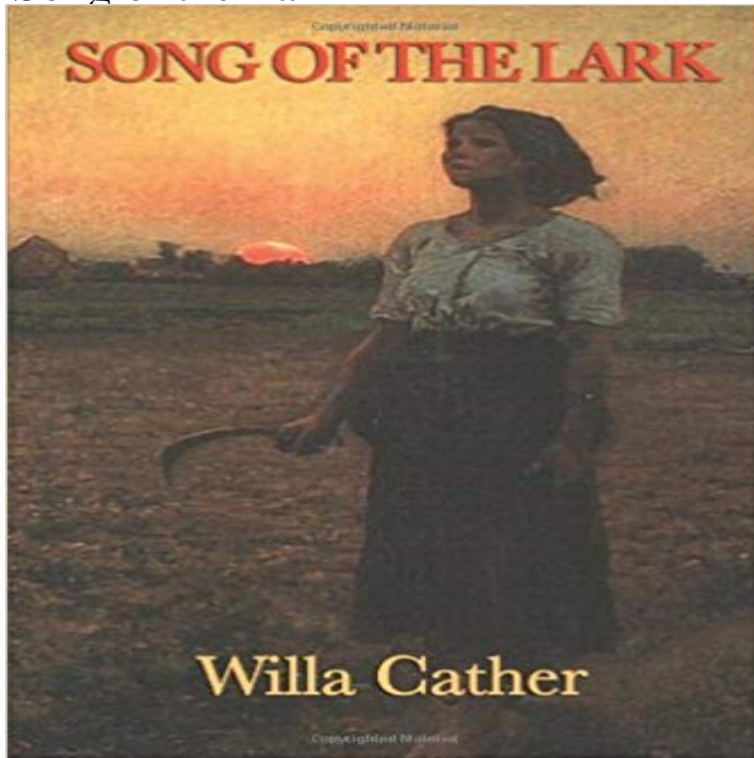


# Song of the Lark
