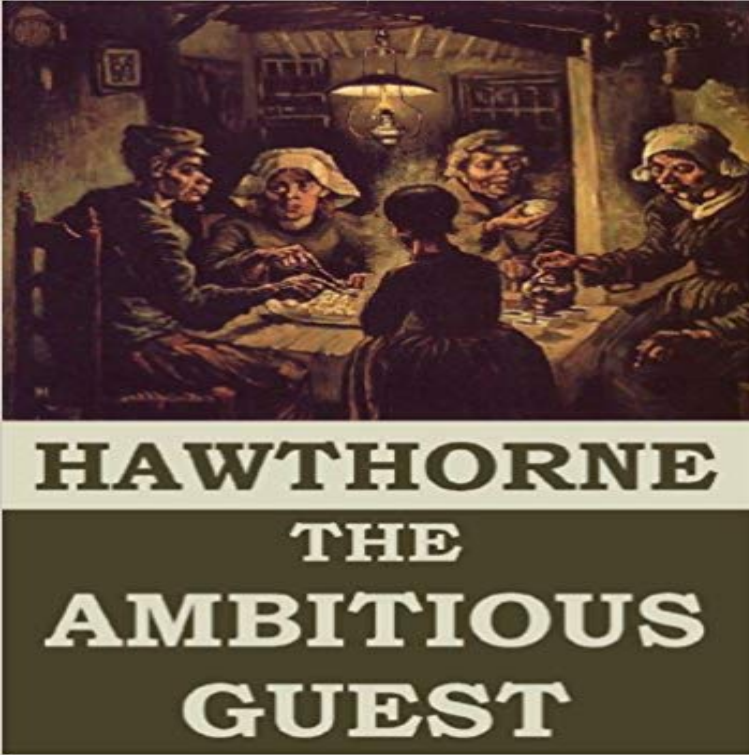


The Ambitious Guest (Annotated)
